CITY & CANAL TOUR

Includes: Private transportation, guide and entrance fee.

Description: Brief visit to Old Panama, the first Spaniard city on the Pacific side. The Colonial Panama, The World Heritage which keep the colonial façade. The new city composed of an international banking district and impressive sky lines that make this city, located front of a bay, one of the most modern of Latin America; observe the variation of three cities in one. And, the Panama Canal, considerate the eight wonder of the world and one of the world's most impressive works of engineering.



Recommendations: Good walking shoes (tennis shoes preferably), light clothes, camera or video camera, sun lotion, sunglasses, baseball cap or hat, and cash money for souvenir shop.

FORT SAN LORENZO AND GATUN LOCKS

Includes: Private transportation, guide, park contribution, and entrances.

Description: We will visit an amazing Spaniard fortification which was built as part of a defense site of the Caribbean. Moreover, we're going thorough a former US Military Base, Fort Sherman. You will observe a natural forest, coasts, and the mouth of the Chagres River. A visit of Gatun locks is included.



Duration: 08:00hrs – 16:00 approx

Recommendations: Good walking shoes (tennis shoes preferably), fresh outfit, camera or video camera, sun lotion and cash money for any souvenir.

Optional: Travel from the Atlantic to the Pacific by the Railway; It's not scheduled on weekends and local holidays.

PIRATES, BUCCANEERS, CORSAIRS AND FILIBUSTERS (PORTOBELO)

Includes: Private transportation, guide and entrances fees.

Description: We will visit the old Spanish fortification on the Caribbean coast. Enjoy the history of pirates, slaves, gold and silver. In addition, you'll go through the isthmus cost to cost on the first transcontinental railroad in the world.

Duration: 08:00 – 16:00 approx

Recommendations: Good walking shoes (tennis shoes preferably), fresh outfit, camera or video camera, sun lotion and cash money for any souvenir.



Optional: Travel from the Atlantic to the Pacific by the Railway; It's not scheduled on weekends and local holidays.

Canopy Zip-line Tour Rapidly gaining a reputation throughout Panama as one of the finest canopy tour sites operating in the country, Panama Outdoor Adventures in Rio Piedra in the Province of Colon features 9 cables along its course of tree-top zip-lines. Each span sends the guest soaring through the jungle at heights that only the tree dwellers of the canopy can experience. The longest line on the tour is 225 meters long and provides a glimpse of one of the most stunning views of the jungle in the region

EMBERA INDIAN VILLAGE

Includes: Private transportation, national park contribution, cultural program (dance, speech, food, and craft).

Description: From the Chagres National Park we will embark on piraguas (dugout canoes) through the **Chagres River**, where we'll arrive at the Embera village. They will welcome us sharing their culture, traditions, and heritage.



Recommendations: Comfortable hiking shoes and/or sandals (preferably water proofed), fresh outfit, binocular, camera or video camera, zip-lock bag, insect repellent, a raincoat (during rainy season), towel and dry change of clothes.

DAY OF ADVENTURE ON GATUN LAKE

Includes: Land transfer, boat tour on Gatun Lake, lunch and refreshment, guide, and activities, such as: Kayaking, fishing, hiking, and swimming.

Description: Explore one of the largest man-made lake over the world. Observe the immense flora and fauna, and huge ships transiting across the Isthmus of Panama. Also, we observe the work being carried out to expand the canal up-close and we'll visit the only floating lodge on the lake.



Duration: 08:30 – 17:00 approx.

Recommendations: Comfortable shoes or sandals (preferably water proofed), fresh outfit, binocular, camera or video camera, zip-lock bag, insect repellent, sunglasses, sun block, bathing suit, towel and dry change of clothes.
