Impressive Hong Kong island city tour (no meal)



Hong Kong Island, a beautiful mountainous, sub-tropical island with skyscrapers lining its coastal plain. Emerging from the bustling Causeway Bay, we drive along a winding mountain road to Victoria Peak (1809 ft.) for a panoramic view of magnificent Hong Kong Harbor, so much exalted in travel books and postcards. After this, along the Island road, we pass by Deep Water Bay and Repulse Bay before arriving at Aberdeen, an old fishing village where boat dwellers spend their entire life on sampans and believed to be the earliest settlement on the island. It is entirely your [own option](#) to tour the Aberdeen inner harbor by taking a sampan ride, moving on, a value-added prestigious jewelry factory visit be arranged where you can find the famous handcrafted fine jewelry

Deluxe Hong Kong island full day tour (with lunch)

The temple is notable for its many fine, well-polished brass and pewter incense burners. Further up to the famous Victoria Peak by Tram, then Aberdeen Typhoon Shelter is an old traditional fishing village that is hard to find in any other parts of the World. You may gain a deeper insight of the lifestyle of Hong Kong fishing folks by riding on a sampan ([at your own expenses](#)), further to visit Stanley market for shopping at the free market, after this stop at Stanley market, we will make our way through the residential and commercial districts back to your hotel.

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Evening City & Sky 100



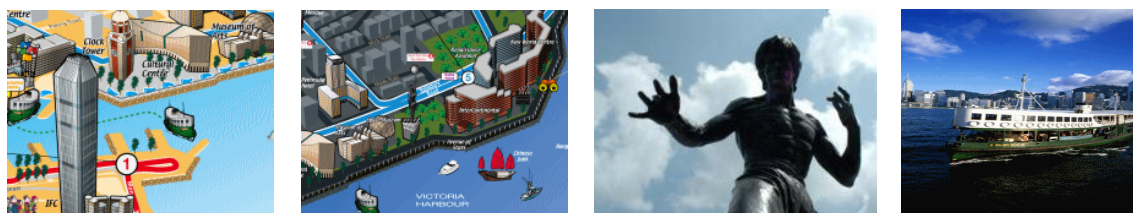

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The land & the sky tour (with lunch)



Tour begins by taking the delightful funicular railway to the Victoria Peak which operating since 1888, then drive through the most visited beach on the southern part of HK is Repulse Bay, it is a popular summer escape for swimmers. Further take a sampan ride for a closer look of the famous Aberdeen typhoon shelter and catch glimpse of the lifestyle of Hong Kong's remaining fisher folks. The dim sum lunch will be arranged at famous Jumbo floating restaurant.

Helicopter flights departs at the city center, be ready to experience an awe-inspiring birds eye view of Hong Kong in 15minutes! (Flight operation is subject to the decision to the helicopter service provider, should the helicopter flight be cancelled due to bad weather or safety reasons, a USD100 per passenger will be refunded)

Impressive Kowloon orientation tour



A half-day tour in Kowloon, it will start towards the local shopping and urban center of Yaumatei with a stop at an open-air market (the famous market – Temple market, Gold fish market; Flower market) where you will be guided to stroll around this local life. Then the tour proceeds to the foothills of Kowloon with a brief stop at Lung Cheung Road Lookout for a panoramic view of "The Kai Tak Cruise Terminal" (the former Kai Tak airport runway) and Kowloon. If time is permit, a visit to the famous Taoism Temple - WONG TAI SIN TEMPLE - to view how believers worship a prophet of the temple. It is estimated that 70% of the total local population are believers.

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Temple & Chinese classical Garden Orientation Tour



Hong Kong has many famous temples, Wong Tai Sin temple; Chi Lin Nunnery & Nan Ling Garden. Wong Tai Sin Temple, its a Taoist temple, is one of busiest and probably best known temple with over 10,000 visitors each day. The temple, which is adorned with ornate Chinese architecture, provides a tranquil environment amongst the surrounding high-rise buildings. Chi Lin Nunnery was first opened in 1934 but substantially rebuilt in a major project involving designers, architects and traditional craftsmen from China, Hong Kong and Japan, before being opened to the public in May 2000. The design follows the ancient rules of Chinese architecture and fung shui principles. In constructing the buildings no nails were used, instead traditional techniques of bracketing and dowels were employed to hold the timber structures together and only natural materials such as clay, stone and wood were used. Nan Ling Garden is a classic traditional Garden in Tang's century style. The garden is characterized by the four main elements of Tang-style gardens with artificial hillocks and ornamental rocks, water features, timber structures and old trees. The Chinese tradition of "earth enclosing rocks" is adopted for the formation of hillocks in the garden.

Ocean Park Hong Kong is Asia's premier sea life and animal theme park, the park features one of the largest aquariums in the world and the largest of its kind in Southeast Asia. Other attraction includes exhibits of sea lions, dolphins, birds and giant Pandas. In addition to the animals, a large assortment of thrill rides will provide a full filled day for all visitors. A famous cable car ride which spans the lowlands and headlands of Ocean Park, for 12-15 minutes, view the southern shores and the most popular attraction in the Park; such as Ocean Theatre; Giant Panda Habitat.

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The Land Between (no meal)



The New Territories is an enormously diverse suburban area full of contrasts to the cosmopolitan city center; the “Land between” is the land bridging the motherland in China and the city center of Hong Kong. It stands both as gentle reminder of Hong Kong’s past and its hope for closer relationship with the motherland.

We will visit the Yuen Yuen institute – a religious complex that demonstrates the significance of Confucian, Taoist and Buddhist contributions to the society. Then tour to the Hong Kong highest mountain – Tai Mo Sha; Luk Keng and visit the fishing farming zone – Sam Mun Tsai; you can see how local fisher folks breed fish in submerged cages.

The Heritage Tour (no meal)



Hidden away among high rise apartment towers and busy highways, the past lives on in the New Territories... a living museum shaped by the rise and development of the so called five great clans of Hong Kong (the Tang; Hau; Pang; Liu and Man). Taking in historic sites around the New Territories, the Heritage Tour brings to life the customs and cultures of these clans and provides a fascinating glimpse of Hong Kong’s rich heritage.

Tour will visit the Tai Fu Tai & Fan Tin Village. The opulent stately home built in 1865 by a scholar of the Man clan, then visit Walled village and the famous wishing tree and Tai Po Market.

Lantau Island & lunch at Monastery Tour + Sky Rail + Ngong Ping village



Lantau island is the biggest island in town which is one of the best place to get away, Visitors will enjoy some of the best views during their joyful 25-minute ride on the cable car: the vistas of the distant and vast South China Sea, you may have the opportunity to see, pay a visit to the quaint fishing village – Tai O, where houses are on stilts. Ngong Ping Village is set on a 1.5-hectare site on Lantau Island; this amazing cultural themed village has been architecturally designed and landscaped to reflect the cultural and spiritual integrity of the Ngong Ping area. You can also go further up to the world's tallest outdoor bronze seated Buddha statue at the Po Lin Monastery and enjoy a great vegetarian meal.

You will see the statue of Kum Iam, its made of bronze with 20 meters height, also the Macau Tower which is ranked the 11th highest in the world, then will visit the famous temple "A-Ma Temple" which built in 1488. The St. Paul's Ruins (1602) and Senado Square & mount Fortress; walking down from St. Paul's way to the city center, enclosed by historical buildings of the St. Dominic's church, holy house of Mercy. The square is a pedestrian zone, it is inscribed in the UNESCO world heritage list in 2005. A short visit of one the Casinos in Macau; offer a large variety of casino games that give versatile entertainment to visitors (age below 18 is not allowed).

An exciting cruise helps to brighten up your day. It sails out to the Eastern Harbour, along Central, Wanchai, Causeway Bay and North Point. Ready your camera to capture the most famous landmarks and architectures, including ICC, IFC, HSBC Headquarter Building, the Bank of China Tower and Hong Kong Convention and Exhibition Center, then follow by the Shau Kei Wan Typhoon Shelter - home of the fishing families and their deep sea fishing junks. Further sailing to Lei Yue Mun Village waterfront, the highlight of the Kowloon City promenade is the newly built Kai Tak Cruise Terminal, opened at the site of the former Kai Tak International Airport. The Terminal is an important tourism infrastructure project enhancing Hong Kong to become a regional transport hub for cruise liners.

Symphony of lights - harbour dinner cruise



"A Symphony of Lights" has been awarded the world's "Largest Permanent Light and Sound Show" by Guinness World Records. This nightly spectacle combines interactive lights of 33 key buildings on both Hong Kong Island and Kowloon with musical effects to showcase the vibrancy and glamorous night vista of Victoria Harbour. Board the sightseeing cruise boat as she sails around the Victoria Harbour, one of the world's most impressive natural harbours. At nighttime, the spectacular Hong Kong's skyline on both sides of the harbour will fire your imagination as the dazzling neon cityscape emerges. The cruise climaxes as the Symphony of Lights show brightens up the skyline with a spectacular display of laser beams bouncing off skyscrapers from both sides of the harbour every night from 8:00pm-8:20pm. The synchronized 20-minute display to music and commentary depicts the growth of Hong Kong from a sleepy fishing village to the dynamic world city it is today. Light buffet dinner to be served on board.

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Treasure Island – Cheung Chau by ferry



Cheung Chau outlying island tour, we take approx. one-hour ride by ferry, Cheung Chau is now the most populous of the outlying islands. There is also a sizeable fishing community here, part of which resides on the junks and sampans anchored in the typhoon shelter surrounding the ferry pier. You will have guide tour in Cheung Chau where you will find narrow alleys, old creaking homes and shops, burning incense and drying fish. There are also some pleasant walks around the northern and southern ends of the island. The other interesting is the Pak Tai Temple, built in 1783 to honor a Taoist deity who vanquished the Demon King and his allies. Pak Tai has become the patron god of Cheung Chau.
