

TASMANIA EXTENSION-BTCTEA

This small group tour starts on Saturday at Hobart and finishes at Launceston. Bringing you into contact with pristine wilderness, unique wildlife, beautiful beaches, a sense of history and the best of contemporary Tasmanian hospitality. This five day tour allows you to experience the magic of Australia's Island State. Designed by people who know and love Tasmania, this small group tour incorporates Tasmanian icons such as the UNESCO World Heritage listed Cradle Mountain, famous Wineglass Bay, the Tasmanian devil, the convict ruins of Port Arthur and some off the beaten path destinations.

The tour includes: Small group touring with an English speaking local guide, transport in comfortable well-appointed vehicle, 4 nights' accommodation, 4 x breakfast(B), 4 x lunch(L), Entry to Bonorong, Entry to Port Arthur Historic Site, National Parks Passes and Hobart airport transfer. Small program changes possible without notice.

Day 1 (Saturday): Hobart

Arrival in Tasmania's capital city, Hobart and transfer to your accommodation. Enjoy a day at leisure in Hobart. You might like to allow time to stroll through Hobart's legendary Salamanca Markets and to visit Tasmania's newest attraction, MONA. The Museum of Old & New Art is one of the world's most unique and controversial museums. View the largest private art collection in Australia with its fascinating blend of ancient and modern art. **Inclusions of the day:** private transfer airport to hotel and 4* accommodation in Hobart.

Day 2 (Sunday): Bonorong – Mt Field National Park

Today, travel to Bonorong Wildlife Sanctuary to experience Tasmanian Devils, Wombats, Wallabies, Quolls and other Australian animals first hand. Continue to Tasmania's oldest National Park, Mt Field. Explore the green forest canopy of the National Park with a rainforest walk to Russell Falls and a beautiful circuit via Horseshoe Falls and the Tall Trees. Here you crane your neck to see some of the tallest trees in the world. **Inclusions of the day:** breakfast, lunch and 4* accommodation in Hobart.

Day 3 (Monday): Tasman Peninsula – Port Arthur – Freycinet Peninsula

Enjoy a scenic drive to Tasmania's East Coast. Explore the Tasman Peninsula where you will visit Port Arthur and hear the story of Tasmania's famous UNESCO world heritage convict settlement. Continue to the Freycinet Peninsula with its exceptional beauty, pristine white sandy beaches and granite coastline. **Inclusions of the day:** breakfast, lunch and 4* accommodation in Freycinet.

Day 4 (Tuesday): Freycinet National Park - Launceston

This morning there will be time to explore the unsurpassed beauty of the Freycinet Peninsula. Take an interpreted walk to the world famous Wineglass Bay lookout for some stunning photo opportunities. Continue your journey to Launceston for an introductory tour and explore the scenic Cataract Gorge where the Tamar River forces its way through sheer rocky cliffs. **Inclusions of the day:** breakfast, lunch and 4* accommodation in Launceston.

Day 5 (Wednesday) Cradle Mountain - Launceston

After breakfast leave Launceston and travel to UNESCO world heritage listed Cradle Mountain National Park. Your guide will introduce you to the many endemic fauna and flora species of the region whilst enjoying picturesque views of the spectacular craggy peaks of Cradle Mountain. After lunch return to Launceston where your guide will bid you farewell. **Inclusions of the day:** breakfast and lunch.

Day 5 (Wednesday) Launceston

- **Private departure transfer** to the airport with English-speaking Driver (flight not included)
