TOUR DESCRIPTION

HALF DAY CITY TOUR (3.5hrs) (WITHOUT SINGAPORE FLYER)

Explore the city by driving around the **Civic District**, passing by the Padang, Cricket Club, historic Parliament House and National Gallery Singapore. The Gallery consists of two national monuments – the former Supreme Court Building and City Hall. Make a photo stop here and view these magnificent buildings up close (Weather permitting)

Stop at the Merlion Park and enjoy the impressive views of Marina Bay. Do not miss out this picture-taking opportunity with The Merlion, a mythological creature that is part lion & part fish.

Visit **Thian Hock Keng Temple**, one of Singapore's oldest Buddhist-Taoist Temple, before driving pass Chinatown.

Proceed to Singapore's first UNESCO World Heritage Site – the Singapore Botanic Gardens and walk through the National Orchid Garden which boasts a sprawling display of 60,000 orchid plants.

Let your senses come alive at Little India as you walk past shops along the five-footway offering a variety of exotic fruits , spices, jasmine and orchid garlands.

Proceed to Singapore's first UNESCO World Heritage Site – the Singapore Botanic Gardens and walk through the National Orchid Garden which boasts a sprawling display of 60,000 orchid plants.

Admire magnificent colonial government buildings that reflect Singapore's colonial heritage. Fall in love with century-old go downs and shop houses restored to their original grandeur and rejuvenated into some of the most enchanting and chic quayside dining and entertainment destinations.

The cruise passes by many grand old bridges of diverse designs decorated with quaint old lamps of a bygone era. Through all these, one will learn the pivotal role Singapore River played in bringing about the phenomenally exceptional economic and social progress tiny Singapore has made in a short period of time.

Visit Thian Hock Keng Temple, one of Singapore's oldest Buddhist-Taoist temples, before driving past

Chinatown. Proceed for a fulfilling handmade Delicious Dim Sum Lunch at Local Restaurant

Then proceed to Arab Street, this historic focal point of the Muslims Life in Singapore, this favourite shopping street is famed for its colourful textiles and rattan ware. Pick up a length of shimmering Indian Silk or an Indonesian Batik Sarong (exquisitely printed cotton wrap).

Visit the magnificent SULTAN MOSQUE, a landmark not to be missed in ARAB STREET, Built in 1928, the mosque is one of the most impressive religious buildings in Singapore. See the sunshine reflects off the massive golden domes and the huge prayer hall.

Next visit the Little India, here the heartland of the Indian community is a cocophony of colours, sound and scents. You will discover an array of Indian Silk, Brassware and Bangles that fascinate you OR simply find out what goes behind the temple doors. Follow your nose to the excellent restaurants in Little India serving North and South Indian Cuisine.

The final stop is Singapore's first UNESCO World Heritage Site – the Singapore Botanic Gardens and walk through the National Orchid Garden which boasts a sprawling display of 60,000 orchid plants.

PERANAKAN TRAIL TOUR (3.5hrs)

Join us a colourful journey into the history, lifestyle and unique character of the **Peranakan Babas (the men) and Nonyas (the women)**.

A fascinating Display of Peranakan costume, embroidery, beadwork, jewellery, porcelain, furniture and craftwork provides insight into the captivating culture of the Peranakans.

Wanders through the bustling enclaves of **Katong & Joo Chiat** that showcases the rich and baroque Peranakan architecture. Admire rows of colourful traditional shop houses that date back to 1920s and 1930s. Get to sample some of the **Nonya Delicacies.....**

EAST COAST & CHANGI TOUR(3.5hrs)

Allow our guide recount stories of collective spirits that rose through the darkest times of World War II as you proceed with your tour of **Changi Chapel & Museum**.

A drive through the rustic and laid-back **Changi Village** gives you a chance to see the relaxing side of Singapore and provides a contrast to Tampines New Town, a typical heartland township of present day Singapore.

Soak in the rich cultural heritage of the **Malays at the Malay Ethnic Area**.

SINGAPORE BY NIGHT (4hrs) (WITH BUMBOAT RIDE & DINNER)

Dinner at local Chinese Restaurant before we start the tour

Take a Bum boat ride by cruising the Singapore River, one will marvel at the extravagant contrast between the richly- mellowed old architectures and strikingly skyscraper skyline of modern Singapore's tourism industry.

After bumboat, enroute pass the world's **largest fountain**, the beautifully illuminated Fountain of Wealth, and admire the spectacular views of Singapore's central business district from Benjamin Sheares Bridge.

Next, advance and explore the bustling night market at **Bugis Street**, ambling through its neon-lit maze of bargain stalls. Wander along the narrow lanes of Night Market and test your bargaining skills against street vendors selling anything from souvenirs to leather goods.

SINGAPORE NIGHTOUT AT CHINATOWN WITH BUMBOAT RIDE , TRISHAW & DINNER (4hrs)

Dinner at local Chinese Restaurant before we start the tour

Continue to Chinatown - Chinatown has come a long way since the early days when Chinese immigrants made this enclave their home. Filled with a sprawling myriad of shops and eateries, bustling with colourful and exciting activities set against a backdrop of rich history and heritage, Chinatown is not to be missed especially in the evening when everything really comes alive.

At a Chinese Medical Hall, learn how Traditional Chinese Medicine helps to regulate your Yin And Yang. From ancient days till modern times, the Chinese have continue with herbs and practices like acupuncture, moxibustion, tai chi & tui na to stay healthy.

The highlight of the evening is the trishaw ride that takes you through the streets of Chinatown and down to Clarke quay.

There hop onto a bumboat for a cruise along the Singapore River to see shop houses, modern skyscrapers of the financial district, colonial buildings and the iconic Merlion Statue.

MORNING @ THE ZOO (3.5hrs)

Leave the city behind as we head north to Mandai and visit one of the world's top and most beautiful zoos. **The Singapore Zoo*** is spread over 28 hectares and is haven to over 3,600 mammals, birds and reptiles including some rare and endangered species. Natural barriers like streams, rock walls and beautiful landscaping are used to separate the animals from visitors thus creating an 'open zoo' effect. Come and

experience a close brush with nature from the comfort of your **Tram** and on foot.

JURONG BIRD PARK TOUR (3.5HRS)

Home to 5,000 birds of 400 species, **Jurong Bird Park** spans 20.2 hectares of lush greenery within Singapore's model industry estate.

Visit 1,000 colorful lorries and have a chance to feed them at the Lory Loft - the world's largest Lory Flight Aviary. Take a ride on the Tram to visit the African Waterfall Aviary.

Enjoy the spectacular Penguin Expedition and High Flyer Show at the Pool Amphitheatre.

The Bird Park's exhibits and aviaries are specially designed to closely resemble the natural habitats of the birds.

NIGHT SAFARI TOUR (4hrs) (WITHOUT DINNER)

The world's **first Night Safari**, set in 40 hectares of secondary jungle, will unfold the mystery and drama of the tropical jungle after dusk with stunning effects.

See a myriad of nocturnal animals, from fierce predators to timid forest dwellers, in their natural habitat under subtle moon-glow lighting.

With priority boarding, you won't have to wait in line to board the tram which will take you through the East and West Loop. Pass by a large reservoir and weave through selected habitats designed specifically to replicate the natural environment from the Himalayan Foothills to the Southeast Asian Rain forest and Indian Subcontinent.

Let the guide take you on a walking trail to view some animals to close quarters. There will also be an opportunity to catch either the Thumbuakar performance of fire-eating skills OR a 20 min animal extravaganza at the Creatures of the Night Show, subject to weather conditions.

Cloud Forest - Be awed by the world's tallest indoor waterfall at 35-metre amidst the lush vegetation and tropical epiphytes. Take a walk on our Cloud Walk and Tree Top Walk for an aerial view of the canopy.

OCBC Skyway - At a height of 22 metres, this 128 metre long aerial walkway is an experience not to be missed.

Flower Dome - Voted as the largest Glass Greenhouse in Guinness World Records 2015, the Flower Dome replicates the cool-dry Mediterranean climate featuring 9 different gardens from 5 continents - Australia, America, South Africa & Europe. Wander amongst thousand year old olive trees and unusual Baobabs as you take in sights of the Flower Field Display. Embark on an unforgettable journey into the vibrant, diverse and colorful world of the region's most exquisite orchids.

Cloud Forest - Explore the highlands amidst orchid, pitcher plants and ferns from the cool-moist Tropical Montane region. Be amazed as you encounter the World's Tallest Indoor Waterfall at 35 metres and walk through the surreal mist-filled Cloud Walk and Treetop Walk.

OCBC Skyway - At a height of 22 metres, this 128 metre long aerial walkway is an experience not to be missed.

We will then proceed to the Singapore Flyer - to experience breathtaking panoramic views on Asia's largest observation wheel. For locals and tourists alike, there is only one place in Singapore that offers a bird's eye view of the entire island city. Enveloped safely in a capsule 165 metres above ground level, you will be treated to a visual 360 degree feast of iconic and historical landmarks such as Singapore River, Raffles Place, Merlion Park and Empress Place.

Look towards the ocean and you will be greeted by the waves and waters of the Singapore harbour as you watch the ships sail serenely by.

Next take a stroll along the harbour front - Clifford Pier and be immersed yourself in Wonder Full - an amazing convergence of light, music and sound, where the universal tale of the journey of life is told by masterfully combining both electric lights and laser effects. Come by and witness a stunning 13-minute showpiece of visual effects by the waterfront with the stunning cityscape of Singapore lit up in the backdrop. Wonder Full has been extremely popular with both locals as well as tourists.

TIONG BAHRU WALKING TOUR (3.5HRS)

Visit the Pinnacles Duxton, the world's tallest public housing project. Enjoy stunning views of the Singapore skyline from the 50th storey.

Proceed to Tiong Bahru - One of the most happening hoods in town. Lined with row after row of quaint art deco shophouses, the residential estate is jam-packed with some of the city's hottest food and lifestyle establishments, not forgetting the heritage-rich places that offer a slice of traditional Singapore. Carve out a day here in your itinerary and be richly rewarded with wonderful eats, offbeat shopping and a spot of culture.

The 90-year old Qi Tian Gong Temple, one of the Singapore's oldest temples honours the Monkey God,

who bestows blessing and protection.

FOOD TRAIL HERITAGE WALKING TOUR (4HRS)

We will start the tour at a local coffee shop where you will enjoy our first dish...rotiprata – indian-sized version of a flour based pancake with a cup of local tea or coffee.

Our next stop will be a Peranakan shop housemuseum to enjoy some local delicacies such as rice dumplings,otah and famous Nonya kuehs. After enjoying the food and learn about thePeranakan culture, we will walk down East Coast Road and turn to CeylonRod and visit the Hindu Temple, the Sri Senpaga Vinaagar Temple (closedat 1200hrs) is the second oldest Hindu Temple in Singapore.Talk awalk around while soaking in the hypnotic atmosphere, learning about thereligion.

Sit and enjoy a bowl of Laksa at the eponymous Katong Laksa shop before the tour ends.
