Guided tour of Rovinj: Rovinj, the Blue Pearl of the Adriatic, the city of romance and art, one of the most picturesque towns in the Mediterranean. Part of the Venetian Republic for over 500 years, the Old Town is perched on an elevated peninsula, surrounded by Venetian terracotta-roofed houses and crowned by the Church of St. Euphemia from the 18th century whose bell tower dominates the Rovinj silhouette.

Return back to Rovinj.

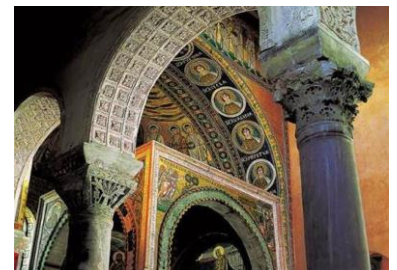

- DAY TRIP TO KAMENJAK NATIONAL PARK

- **HIKING & KAYAKING:** Enjoy kayaking and hiking in the beautiful Kamenjak National Park, about an hour outside Rovinj. Cape Kamenjak is a beautiful nature park located on the Premantura peninsula on the southern tip of Istria. The pretty landscape, rolling hills, miles of rugged coastline, beaches, coves & caves make kayaking in the area a lovely experience. During the kayak tour you will experience natural areas, bays, and cliffs that you can just admire, or even try cliff jumping.

- **HISTRIA AROMATICA – SPECIAL ISTRIAN GARDENS** on 100.000 m2: Istrian meadows and woodlands, plantations and Istrian gardens, cave, museum, aromatic shop, plants and wildlife and more... natural shopping: choose among wide range of natural cosmetics and genetically manufactured products based on autochthonous aromatic herbs (lavender, sage, immortelle, rosemary, laurel...)

- **VISIT AMPHITHEATRE IN PULA:** The most famous and important monument, the starting and ending point of every sightseeing tour is the Amphitheatre, popularly called the Arena of Pula, which was once the site of gladiator fights. Gladiator fights took place in the central flat area called the arena, while the spectators could sit on the stone tiers or stand in the gallery. It is believed that the Amphitheatre could seat about 20,000 spectators. In the Middle Ages it was the site of knights' tournaments and fairs. Today, it is the



venue for many different events – Pula Film Festival, various concerts, opera, ballet, sports competitions etc.

DAY 6

Split, Trogir, Krka Waterfalls, Split

After breakfast drive to historical Trogir. Sightseeing in Trogir is a pure joy. It's a small town and Trogir's sights are conveniently clustered together, making it an easy walk and easy to understand why it is a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Start your walking tour from the Renaissance city, above the gate is a statue of the town's protector, the Blessed Ivan Orsini. Nearby is the town museum which gives a good overview of Trogir's history. Continue to the town centre with magnificent cathedral of St. Lovro, built from the 13th to the 15th centuries and considered one of the Adriatic's most architecturally and artistically important monuments. Continue sightseeing to numerous other monuments, like The elegant bell tower, Chapel of Blessed John Orsini, a Renaissance masterpiece, numerous churches and Kamerlengo fortress. Plenty to explore and enjoy this historical Dalmatian town.

Drive further towards National Park Krka Waterfalls, where the river Krka formed cascades and waterfalls of majestic forms. The waterfalls are

a karstic phenomenon: over millennia river water has created a canyon up to 200m deep through limestone hills, bringing calcium carbonate with it. Mosses and algae retain the calcium carbonate and encrust it in their roots. The material is called tufa and is formed by billions of plants growing on top of one another. These growths create barriers in the river that produce spectacular waterfalls.



Fantastic conclusion of your day will be at Bibich Winery: in the cellars of the Bibic Winery, a signature event for lovers of fine wine and food in Croatia. The vineyards are located on the rolling hills above historic Skradin and Krka National Park in the bucolic village of Plastovo. Among the most celebrated in the country, most of Bibic's limited production is sold only in very select shops and served in the Croatian finest restaurants- the rest is exported to US and Europe.



Return to Split and at leisure.

The town is the site of the oldest municipal theatre in Europe which opened in 1612. Trip continues to the legendary island of Vis. We will have an hour of free time to explore this charming seaside hamlet before we take off to enjoy the Paklinski Islands. Return to Dubrovnik in late afternoon.

Wine & Culinary day trip on Hvar island: A full day of wine and great food visiting two of Croatia's premier wineries followed by a delightful authentic lunch/dinner.

Decide between the Romanesque cellars of Andro Tomic (togas optional), a French-educated vintner from Jelsa was the face of Croatian EU integration in his battle to protect the Prosek brand. Or Ivo Dubokovic, whose cozy Jelsa cellar offers an authentic and boutique tasting experience to match his reputation as Croatia's leading boutique winemaker.

Continue to other part of the island to Zlatan Otok, Hvar's most famous producer, complete with underwater tasting rooms, Decanter gold medals and Croatia's only Grand Cru.

Other great options on Hvar Island:

- **CYCLING ON HVAR ISLAND:** Hvar is a natural paradise. What is better way than to experience its magic close up through a challenging bike ride through its fields and picturesque inland villages, where time has stood still, and whose secrets are there to be discovered. Cycle through the inland villages of Dol, Svirce and Vrisnik, before hitting the coast through Jelsa and Vrboska, much of it the route of the 500 year-old UNESCO Easter Procession.

- **HIKING HVAR:** Pathways lead you through the olive trees and lavender fields, through vineyards, forests and inlets. A visit to the old island villages,



of which some are abandoned (Humac, Malo Grablje...), will give you an insight into the past and the old way of life on the island. Hiking to the highest peak called St. Nicholas (628m), from where you can see all islands of central Adriatic and the mountains of hinterland.

- BRAC ISLAND WITH GOLDEN HORN: Day trip to one of top 10 most beautiful beaches in the world on Brac island, called “Golden horn”.

- PRIVATE BOAT RIDE AMONG PAKLENI ISLANDS: A day to marvel and one which will undoubtedly be one of the highlights of your Hvar holiday, this private speedboat tour can be tailored to your specific requests and preferences. Those islands might look all the same, but included in the secrets of the Pakleni Islands is CNN’s top naturist beach in the world, an arboretum, art gallery, one of Croatia’s top beach clubs, Roman ruins and mud bath, the lowest vineyard in Croatia and bays and coves, lots of hidden coves for you to relax and enjoy.

- SCUBA DIVING IN HVAR: There are more than 15 beautiful diving spots within only 5-60 minutes boat drive from Hvar Town. Most of them are around divine archipelago of Pakleni Islands, real Adriatic Paradise.

From the Onofrio fountain to the City bell tower, along its main street, Stradun and in many other small and quiet cobblestone streets, every step in this town will be an experience par excellence. Duration of guided tour: approx. 3 hours

This evening we recommend you to just take a relaxing walk toward the old city before dinner. You may wish to relax by finding a café called Buza that is a cracking little bar perched on rocks beneath the city walls.

Enjoy afternoon and evening in special way:

- **GAME OF THRONES TOUR:** Perfect for die-hard “Game of Thrones” fans. Learn insider stories about the filming of the hit TV show, visit locations like Fort Lovrijenac (the Red Keep), and you even have the chance to play with props from the show. Duration: 2,5 hours.

- **CAVE BAR MORE:** Cave bar is a place where you can have the best morning coffee, spend the afternoon sipping cocktails, or finish the day with a glass of the finest champagne or cognac. Take beach break and enjoy light lunch from the Cave bar summer lunch menu.

- **CITY WALLS OF DUBROVNIK:** Dubrovnik is known for its distinctive Old Town, encircled with massive stone walls completed in the 16th century. A walk along Dubrovnik's famous city walls that surrounds the Old Town is a unique and wonderful experience and a must-do when visiting Dubrovnik. The walls are 1,940 meters long and you can walk all the way around them (it usually takes about 2 hours).

- **FRANCISCAN MONASTERY:** The Franciscan Monastery is owned by the Order of the Friars Minor and the Old Town complex consists of a monastery, a church, a library, a pharmacy and a cloistered garden. The pharmacy and the beautiful gardens are a highlight of a visit: the pharmacy originates from 1317 and is the third oldest pharmacy in the world still in operation.

- **VISIT THE RECTOR'S PALACE:** The 15th Century Gothic-Renaissance Rector’s Palace was originally built for the rector elected to govern



Dubrovnik and now serves as a museum. The notorious dungeon prison, the artwork and original furniture were all fascinating and, for Game of Thrones fans, some Season 2 scenes were shot in the courtyard of the building.

- GO GREEN AT TRSTENO ARBORETUM: The serene Trsteno Arboretum, a leafy botanical garden 18km north of Dubrovnik, was once the summer residence of a Dubrovnik noble family and recently shot to fame as a result of making frequent appearances in Seasons 3 and 4 of Game of Thrones as the King's Landing gardens. Exotic and serene, the renaissance gardens are known to date back as early as the 1400s and are set against the beautiful backdrop of the Adriatic Sea in a small fishing village close to Dubrovnik.
- 4-HOURS SUNSET SAIL TO THE ELAPHITI ISLANDS: End a perfect day in Dubrovnik with a sunset sail that takes you around the Elaphiti Islands. Admire the spectacular colors of the sunset from the deck of a catamaran. Take an active part in the sail or jump in the water for a swim or some snorkeling.

This city had important roles in this region's historical battles between eastern and western cultures. You will visit the city of Pocitelj - a strategic point for the Ottoman Empire, and also have a chance to cool off and swim in untouched nature of beautiful Kravice waterfalls - known as one of Europe's last jungles. - DAY TRIP TO MONTENEGRO: From Dubrovnik, visit Montenegro, a diminutive southeast European country that boasts big things: the UNESCO-World Heritage-listed Bay of Kotor, the walled seaside town of Budva, and the eye-pleasing city of Kotor, situated within Europe's southernmost fjord. - DUBROVNIK SEA KAYAKING TO THE ISLAND OF LOVE (HALF DAY TRIP): Discover secret bays in turquoise clear water & visit Island of Love & hidden cave beach.

- FULL-DAY WINE& CULINARY TRIP OF DUBROVNIK REGION: Visit Niko Karaman’s winery, Divanovic Flour Mill and Konavoski dvori – three things which you will remember forever.
- KONAVOSKI DVORI RESTAURANT: Place of traditional dishes from all Croatian regions. Is this the Mediterranean on the mainland or the mainland bathed in the Mediterranean's ambience? That's the question posed by every visitor who steps into Konavoski Dvori for the first time. Check yourself and indulge yourself in great food along with wine in fascinating atmosphere.
- SUNSET DINNER CRUISE FROM DUBROVNIK: When sunset begins, take a short trip around Dubrovnik and Lokrum Island. Buffet dinner on the 16th century Karaka ship, listening to ambiental music, sipping champagne and listening to the tales of old is an authentic Dubrovnik-style experience that you can't miss!
- DAY TRIP TO MLJET ISLAND: Some says that, while describing the enchanted island of Ogygia, Odysseus, and the nymph Calypso, Homer must have had the island of Mljet in mind. Its National Park is situated in the western part and takes about one third of the island. Its greatest peculiarity are two salt-water lakes: Great and Small Lake with the remnants of a 12th - century Benedictine monastery of Saint Mary. You can walk around or rent a bicycle to explore this fascinating island.

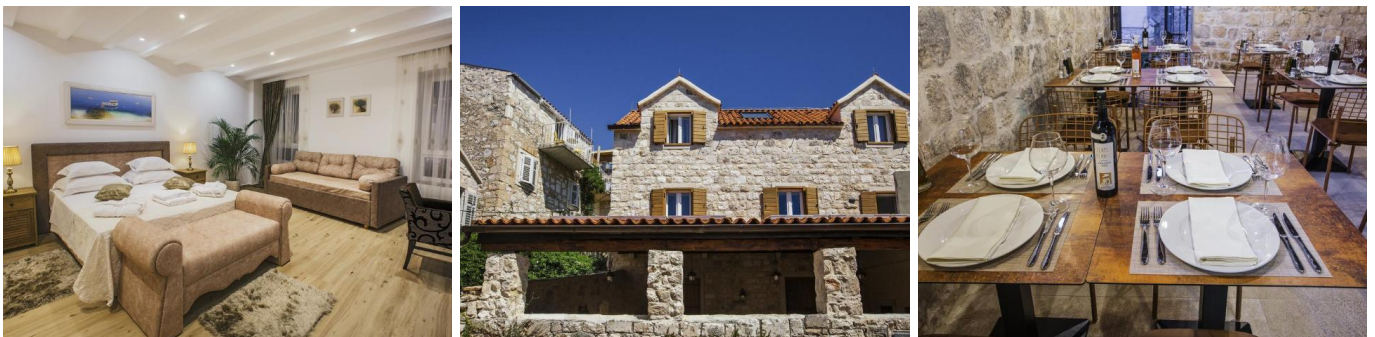
