Tips of the day - OPTIONALLY:

- **VISIT CHIEMSEE LAKE WITH HERRENCHEMSEE PALACE:** On the island of Herreninsel on the Chiemsee, Bavaria's largest

lake, about 60 km southeast of Munich, the stunning palace complex of Herrenchiemsee was started in 1878 by King Ludwig II. He planned it to rival Versailles, but it remained unfinished after he drowned at age 40. If you wish you can continue to the smaller Fraueninsel, or Women's Island with the 8th-century Benedictine convent with its Gothic bell tower is fantastic place to enjoy some typical culinary delights of the island, numerous souvenir

- **HOFBRAUHAUS:** The world-famous Hofbräuhaus brand brings an unparalleled beer culture to the world. Enjoy unique drinking, dining and entertainment experience in one of the world center of beer.

- **DACHAU CONCENTRATION CAMP** was the first of its kind opened in Germany by the Nazi government in 1933, and it served as a model for later concentration camps. Designed to hold Jews, political prisoners, and other "undesirables," the camp is now a memorial to the more than 40,000 people who died and over 200,000 who were imprisoned here during the Nazi regime. The memorial was established in 1965, 20 years after Dachau was liberated by American forces.

- EAGLE'S NEST (approx. 4-5 h)- formerly Hitler's home and southern headquarters: a breathtaking journey up the Kehlstein road and a luxurious brass elevator up through the rock into Eagle's Nest. Enjoy impressive views and its excellent cuisine. The site combines a unique example of historic architecture and a stunning Alpine setting.



- TOP OF SALZBURG (approx. 6 h): Visit the Top of Salzburg, the summit-level panoramic viewing platform on the Kitzsteinhorn, which offers sweeping views of the eastern alps and Hohe Tauern National Park. With your ticket, you'll enjoy access to all the cable cars and lifts up to an altitude of 9,843 feet (3,000 meters), plus entrance to mountain attractions including the Cinema 3000 experience and the Ice Area with snow slides, a magic carpet, and a summertime glacier trail.



- MOZART'S BIRTHPLACE (1-2 h): W. A. Mozart was born in 1756 in the "Hagenauer Haus" at No. 9 Getreidegasse in Salzburg. Today, Mozart's Birthplace is one of the most visited museums in Austria and is an absolute highlight, above all for Mozart fans. The famous composer's birthplace continues to be a magnet for Mozart fans and history buffs from around the world.



- VISIT THE STIEGL BREWERY (approx. 2 h): An ideal trip for a rainy day, the Stiegl Brewery is home to Salzburg's most popular beer. This brewery is located a short bus ride away from the centre of town, in the direction of the airport, and contains various exhibitions and the offer of a beer-tasting session at the end of the tour. The museum takes you through the brewing process, the various advertising campaigns and gives you a brief history of Austrian beer culture. All the production is done locally, with the water for the brewing process sourced from the mountains nearby.



- CASTLE WITH FORTRESS ABOVE SALZBURG (approx. 2 h): Ascend and descend by Fortress funicular, entrance to fortress precincts, guided tour with audio guide in eleven languages (salt storeroom, torture chamber, lookout tower, 'Salzburg Bull' - mechanical organ), Fortress Museum, Rainer Regiment Museum,



Marionette Museum, Alm passage. Besides, visit of unique Princes' Apartments in the main castle and the Mechanical Theatre.

Visit the Aletsch Glacier - Top of Europe Jungfrauoch:

Enjoy a cogwheel train ride through green meadows and the hard rock of the Mountain Eiger to Europe's highest railway station at 11,333 ft: the famous Jungfrauoch (Top of Europe). A visit to the Jungfrauoch is an unforgettable experience in a high-Alpine wonderland of eternal ice and snow and a true highlight of a visit in Switzerland. The Sphinx is the highest vantage point on the Top of Europe at 3,571m. Once at the top you will have magnificent views of the longest ice stream in the Alps, the Aletsch Glacier, which is 22km long and up to 800m thick. The mighty Eiger, Mönch and Jungfrau massif soaring almost vertically up from the valley is also a sight to behold. This whole area is designated as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The average temperature during the summer months varies from around -9c to 1.7c degrees.

Tip of the day - some more options on this day:

- MT. TITLIS: The revolving gondola «Rotair» leads up to 9900 ft. into a breathtaking world of ice and snow. Titlis offers a variety of activities such as the „Ice Flyer“ (a chairlift over the glacier), the „Cliff Walk“ (Europe's highest suspension bridge), a visit to the glacier grotto or the snow park.

- ALPHORN SOUND: Discover how an alphorn works and try to make its distinctive sound ring across the valley for yourself. Experience Swiss customs and traditions as you try and make a sound on the alphorn. You will receive instruction from an experienced alphorn player who will be delighted to answer your questions.

- ROYAL RIDE TO THE PEAK OF MÄNNLICHEN:

ride on a balcony on the roof of the aerial cableway, starting from railway station in Wengen heading up to the peak of Männlichen. If you feel more active you can hike part of the route up or down!

- TOP OF INTERLAKEN - HARDER KULM viewing platform. If Interlaken had a king, he would reside on the Harder Kulm. From the viewing platform at 1,322 metres above sea level he would graciously look down upon Lake Brienz and Lake Thun, or admire the Eiger, Mönch, and Jungfrau. In fact, the Harder Kulm Panorama Restaurant is reminiscent of a castle.

- VISIT OF THE TRÜMMELBACH WATERFALLS: The Trümmelbach Falls are the world's only glacier waterfalls that are accessible underground by lift, galleries, tunnels, paths and platforms. They are part of the Lauterbrunnen Valley's 72 waterfalls, among them also the imposing Staubbach Fall. The hiking tour on mainly flat land leads from Lauterbrunnen to Stechelberg, past water gushing from vertical rock faces that are several hundred meters high. Ticket of 11 CHF/person payable on the spot!

The rural village with the dark sun-burned wooden houses is inviting for shopping and fine eating.</p> <p>Tip of the day - more options in Zermatt:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - GORNERGRAT VIEW POINT: The Gornergrat railway is a mountain rack railway, it links the resort village of Zermatt, situated at 1,604 m above sea level, to the summit of the Gornergrat. Enjoy another fascinating viewpoint from Gornergrat. The Gornergrat (3,089 m) is one of those places that everyone should visit at least once in a lifetime. The mountain panorama and the glorious view of the Matterhorn is unforgettable. - ZERMATT HIKING DAY OF 5 LAKES: The 5-Seenweg (Five Lakes Walk) is in a class of its own among hikes in the Zermatt mountains. The views of the mountain lakes are superb (with the Matterhorn reflected in three of them), and the trail is full of variety. - THE SUNTRAP of SUNNEGGA: From Zermatt you can reach the Sunnegga family paradise by funicular in a few minutes. - **BOTANICAL GARDENS OF LAKE COMO:** part of the Hotel Villa Cipressi, a wonderful building on the lake which was built in the 1400s. The garden is open to the public, whereas the rest of the building belongs to the hotel and its restaurant. The Botanic Garden is a century-old beauty which touches the lake and features several plants and flowers which nature lovers will adore. It is located on different tiers which overlook the waters in sublime ways.
- **DAY TRIP TO LUGANO AND BELLINZONA:** Lugano is a city in southern Switzerland's Italian-speaking Ticino region. Its Swiss-Mediterranean mix of cultures is closely related to that of Italy's northern Lombardy region. This mix is reflected in its architecture and cuisine. The city stands on the northern shore of glacial Lake Lugano, surrounded by mountains. Bellinzona is the capital city of southern Switzerland's Ticino canton. It's known for its 3 medieval castles, including the hilltop Castelgrande and Sasso Corbaro.

Make lasagna, ravioli, and tortellini and then sit down to enjoy the delicious food you've created with local wines. - SHOPPING IN MILAN: Shopping in Milan is about more than designer boutiques: find vintage and budget-friendly treats at these local shops. There is no lack of high-octane fashion flagships in the centre of this Italian metropolis, shopping in Milan is a world-renowned activity and one of the best things to do in town, after all. Most major brands are well-represented in the so-called Quadrilatero d'Oro ("golden rectangle") fashion district – bordered by Via Senato and Via Merone to the north and south and Corso Venezia and Via Manzoni to the east and west. - LAST SUPPER PAINTING at Santa Maria delle Grazie Church: Inside the refectory of the Dominican convent close to the church of Santa Maria delle Grazie, you can admire one of the world's most celebrated works: The Last Supper by Leonardo da Vinci, painted between 1494 and 1498 under the dukedom of Ludovico il Moro. reason that a museum named after this man contains many of his works and a huge collection of other important scientific and technological displays.

- **SHOPPING MALL GALLERIA VITTORIO EMANUELE II:** Galleria Vittorio Emanuele II is not your typical shopping mall – it's one of the world's oldest and consists of a four-story double arcade with a glass-vaulted roof. The Galleria's history dates back to the years between 1860 and 1864. During this time, the city held a series of competitions to solicit architectural proposals in order to modernize Piazza del Duomo and connect it with Piazza della Scala. In the end, Giuseppe Mengoni's project was approved. Today, the Galleria is often referred to as *il salotto di Milano*, or Milan's living room, because it is a common meeting spot amongst residents of the city.

- **La Scala in Milan** is one of most famous opera houses in the world. The theatre was inaugurated on 3 August 1778 and was originally known as the *Nuovo Regio Ducale Teatro alla Scala* (New Royal-Ducal Theatre alla Scala). The premiere performance was Antonio Salieri's *Europa riconosciuta*.

Most of Italy's greatest operatic artists, and many of the finest singers from all around the world, have appeared at La Scala. The theatre is regarded as one of the leading opera and ballet theatres in the world and is home to the La Scala Theatre Chorus, La Scala Theatre Ballet and La Scala Theatre Orchestra. We arrange for you also tickets for the performances in this famous building.
